- Provide several Outreach events throughout the year for the purpose of sharing Christ with as many students as possible.
- Involve the students in the OMN's Fine Arts Festival and Speed-the-Light giving.
- Assist in the leading of a Missions trip every year. Our goal is to see every Bethel youth participate in at least one missions experience before they graduate from HS.
- Train students to be effective in sharing Christ on their school campuses.
- Develop a relationship tie with local schools, including CCHS.
- Conduct a quality annual Winter Camp and Summer Camp each year.

- Attend all all-church events arriving at least 30-minutes early and staying late, as needed.
